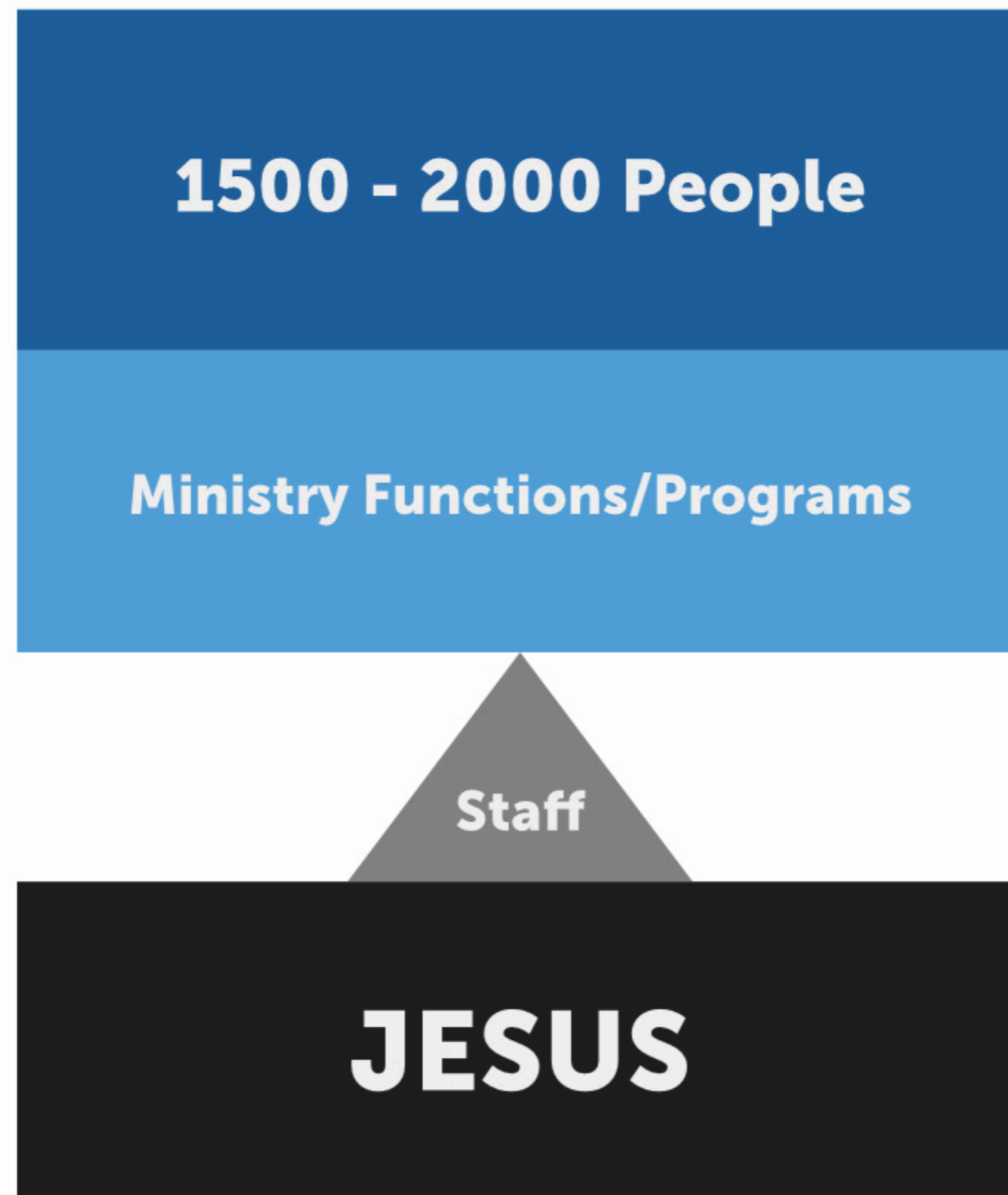
# One Purpose

Genesis 1:26-28; Matthew 24:14, 28:18-20; Acts 1:8

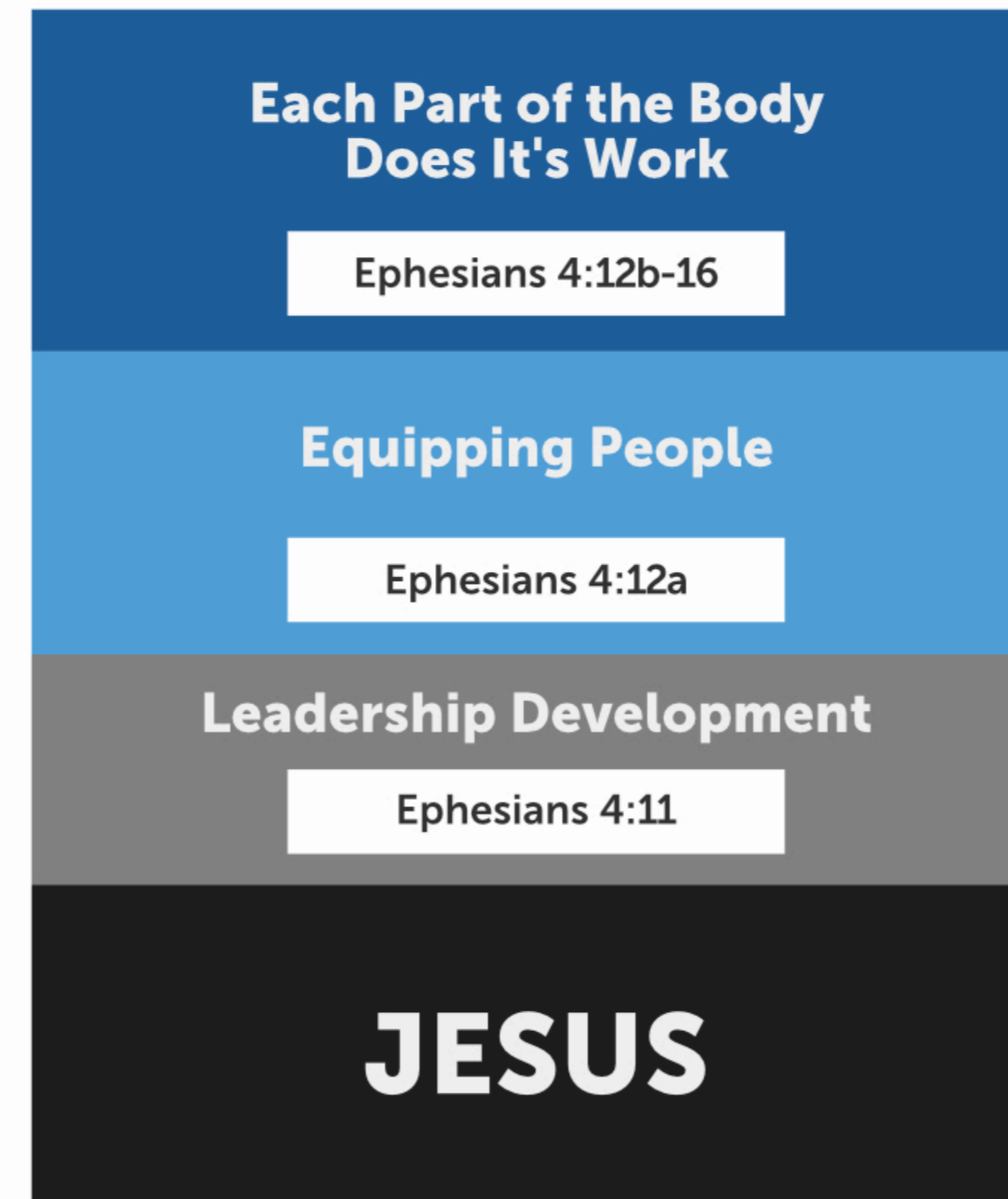
# Two Goals

2. The Church moves from the “Pastoral” or “Dependency” model of ministry.



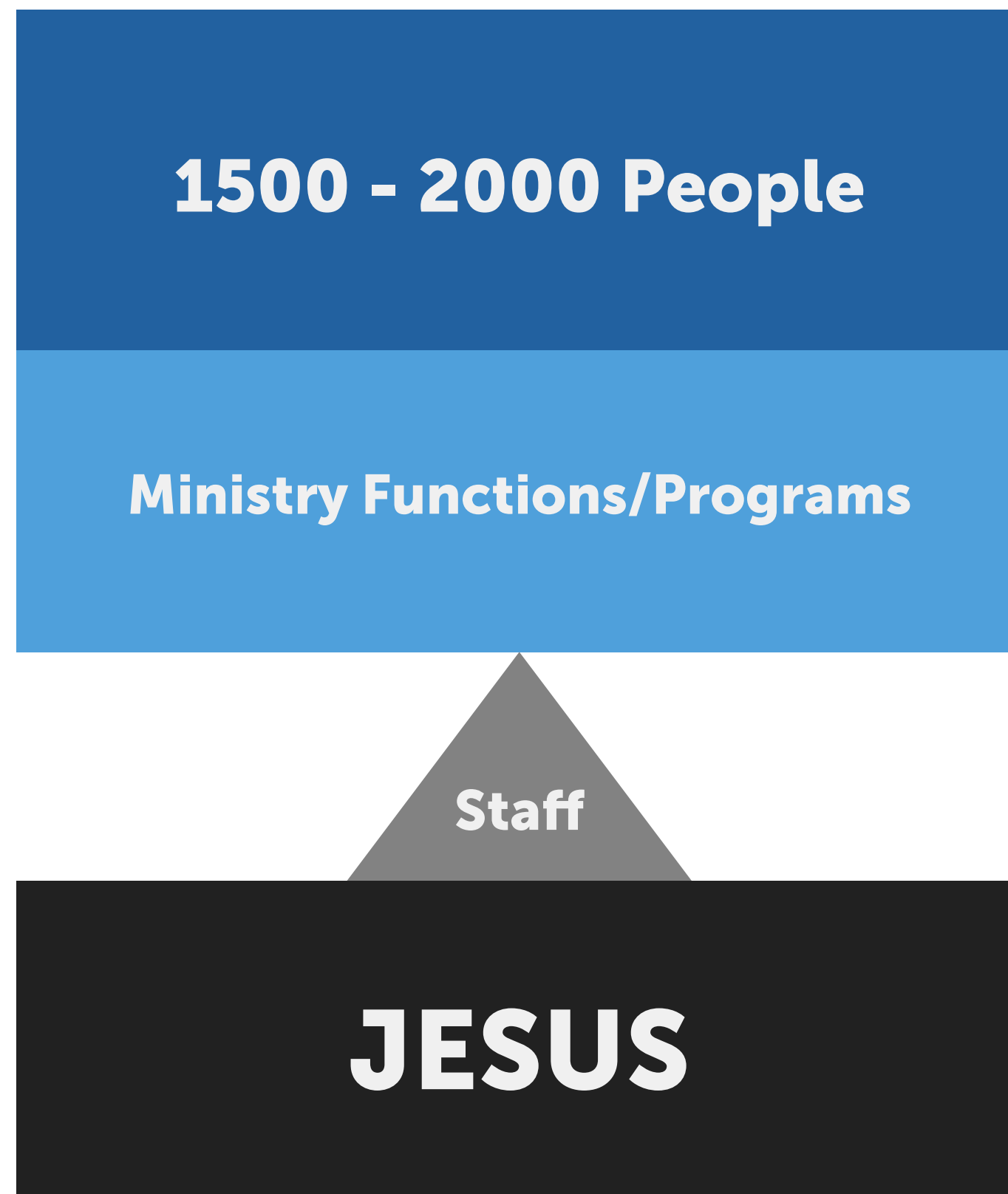
### PASTORAL MODEL
